

# MI Test


A quick walkthrough for installing and using the MI Test tool in the Infor M3 H5 client.

#### **Requirements**





For the installation of this tool, you will need access to the Administration Tools menu in your M3 environment.







# **Upload Application**










Assuming no errors, you'll get a confirmation dialog box.

## **Get Application URL**




The application should now be listed in the Installed applications section of the page. You will see a path URL. Click on it to get the full path. You will get a 403 error, this is normal. Copy the URL from the browser, and store it somewhere, you will need it soon.




Close this tab, and then click the Administration Tools in M3.


# **Setup Menu for MI Test**




Open MNS110 in M3




In the Function field (1), enter MITEST in all caps. Then Click on the Add button (2).







When you hit Enter, you will see the URL Address. Paste the address we documented previously for the Application, then add **mitest/** to the end. Everything is case sensitive, so match it. After this text is entered, click Next.




Enter MI Test for both the Name and Description, then click Next.



This will return you to the MNS110 Menu. Right-Click on the new Function, MITEST, select Related, then Menu.




Enter Option 2, and Menu API, then click the Add button




Click Next, then press F3 on the keyboard to close. You may then Exit MNS110. Restart the Client.


#### **Restart M3**
