What is Infor Smart Rules?

Infor Smart Rules is an Eclipse plug-in designed to assist developers in creating rules for Event Analytics, part of Event Hub. Event Analytics is built upon JBoss Drools Expert, a rule engine.

Installing and Verifying Eclipse

Install Eclipse
Note: You can have multiple Eclipse installations as long as they are located in different folders.
1 Download the correct Eclipse package from http://www.eclipse.org/downloads.
2 Extract the files to your local hard drive. The extracted zip file creates a folder named Eclipse.
Verify installed Eclipse version
1 Open the Eclipse folder where the extracted zip file is stored. Double-click the file <i>eclipse.exe</i> to start the Eclipse application. If the publisher cannot be verified, a dialog box will appear asking if you want to run the software. Click Run.
2 Browse the workspace folder where you want to store your projects. Click OK.
3 From the Eclipse menu, select Help > About Eclipse SDK.
The About Eclipse SDK window displays the version of installed Eclipse.

Installing Infor Smart Rules

Add an Infor Smart Rules update site in Eclipse
The update site for Infor Smart Rules is delivered as a zip archive1 Start Eclipse.
2 From the Eclipse menu, select Help > Install New Software. The Available Software window appears.
3 Click Add.
4 In the Add Repository window, click Archive.
5 Browse to the file smartrules.eclipse.repository-2.x.x-yyyymmdd.hhmmss-n.zip.Click Open.
6 Click OK. The Infor Smart Rules update site now appears in the Work with field.
The Infor Smart Rules update site is added successfully if you can select the update site and no error messages appear.
Install Infor Smart Rules plug-in
1 Start Eclipse.
2 From the Eclipse menu, select Help > Install New Software.
3 In the Work with field, select the Infor Smart Rules update site.
4 Select Infor Smart Rules. Click Next.
5 In the Install Details window, the Infor Smart Rules item is listed. Click Next.
6 Accept the terms of the license agreement. Click Finish.
7 A Security Warning dialog box appears asking if you want to continue with the installation. Click OK.
8 You will be prompted to restart Eclipse to apply the changes. Click Restart Now.
Eclipse is restarted and the Infor Smart Rules is now installed.

Verifying the Infor Smart Rules Installation

1 Start Eclipse.	
2 From the Eclipse menu, select Help > Install New Software. The Available Software window appears.	
3 Click the link to What is already installed? The Installed Software tab appears by default.	
4 Verify that the Infor Smart Rules is listed under the installed software.	
5 Select the Plug-ins tab. In the column for Provider, look for Infor Smart Rules and check if the Infor Smart Rules Help and Thirdparty Bundle are also installed.	ıe

Uninstalling Infor Smart Rules

1 Start Eclipse.
2 From the Eclipse menu, Select Help > Install New Software. The Available Software windo appears.
3 Click the link to What is already installed?
4 In the Installed Software tab, select Infor Smart Rules (Required). Click Uninstall.
5 In the Uninstall Details window, confirm that the Infor Smart Rules is listed. Click Finish.
6 You will be prompted to restart Eclipse to apply the changes. Click Restart Now.
Eclipse is restarted and the Infor Smart Rules is now uninstalled.
